

NORTH COAST RC MODELERS CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I – Title

The name of the organization, a non-profit association, shall be North Coast RC Modelers.

ARTICLE II - Purpose

The North Coast RC Modelers is formed to unite the radio control model builders and flyers, in an effort to better the conditions and pleasure of radio controlled modeling. The organization shall strive to provide a suitable flying site for use by members. The organization shall maintain chartering by the Academy of Model Aeronautics for furthering and safeguarding of these purposes.

ARTICLE III – Membership

Membership shall be open to any person who supports the purpose of North Coast RC Modelers and who meets the requirements set forth in the bylaws of this constitution.

ARTICLE IV - Officers

The officers shall consist of president, vice president, secretary-treasurer, safety officer and any additional office required for chartering purposes by the Academy of Model Aeronautics. Officers shall be nominated, elected, appointed, removed and have responsibilities and perform the duties as set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V - Meetings

Regularly scheduled meetings open to attendance and participation by members, guests and the general public shall be held at the times and places agreed to by the membership. Special meetings may be called by the president when necessary.

ARTICLE VI- Voting

Voting shall govern affairs of the North Coast RC Modelers as set forth in this constitution and its bylaws.

ARTICLE VII- Procedure

The rules contained in Roberts Rules of Order (revised) shall govern this association in the cases to which they are applicable and not inconsistent with the constitution and bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII- Alteration and Amendments

Alterations and amendment of this constitution and/or its bylaws shall be adopted by a three fourths affirmative vote of membership present during a regularly scheduled meeting, providing at least one third of eligible voting members are in attendance, and provided that a notice and the text of the proposed change is made available to all members 28 days prior to the meeting either by mail, a posting at the airfield or posting on the organization's web page.
